3. Rules

The competition is HKSPA-rated.

Each side has 25 minutes to complete the game. WESPA Rules Version 3 will be followed.

The rules are for reference only. There will be officials observing the games so you do not need to study the rules in great detail.

4. Observers

Teachers are allowed to watch the games and take photos during the **first 5 minutes of each game**. However, all observers must not communicate with the players via any means during game time.

Reserved players and players finishing their games are not allowed to observe the games.

5. Competition Mechanism

A team-based Swiss system will be used in the Championship.

In case of an odd number of schools, a mixed team will be formed by reserved players.

After 5 games, a final ranking will be compiled based on 1) number of school wins; 2) number of individual wins; 3) total spread.

A school WIN refers to a 3-0 or 2-1 victory. A DRAW refers to 3 individual draws or 1 individual win, 1 individual loss, 1 individual draw.
