15-year-old Hong Kong student got the "Most Improved Player" award in the World Youth Scrabble Championship 2017

Brian Po Chun Wo, a 15-year-old Hong Konger, got the "Most Improved Player" award at the World Youth Scrabble Championship 2017 (called "WESPA Youth Cup" this year). The WESPA Youth Cup, featuring 176 players, was held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia from 27 to 29 November. Brian, the highest placed Hong Kong player in the tournament, finished 32nd with 14.5 wins. He made a great improvement from his 83rd place finish in 2016.

It is the third time the Hong Kong Scrabble Players Association ("HKSPA") sends players to the annual youth championship, following the successes of the previous teams to Australia and France. HKSPA, established in 2014, is the national Scrabble association of Hong Kong. HKSPA aims to promote Scrabble to students and the general public in Hong Kong.
