3. Rules

Each side has 25 minutes to complete the game. WESPA Rules Version 3 will be followed, except that overrun is not allowed.

The rules are for reference only. There will be officials observing the games so you do not need to study the rules in great detail.

The two players from the same school are allowed to communicate with each other during the game. You are advised to communicate via pen and paper so that your opponents will not hear your strategies.

4. Observers

Teachers are allowed to watch the games and take photos during the competition. However, all observers must not communicate with the players via any means during game time.
