Over 30 schools participate in the 2nd Inter-school Scrabble Championship held by HKSPA

The Hong Kong Scrabble Players Association, established in 2014, is the recognised official Scrabble Association in Hong Kong. The Association aims to promote Scrabble to students and the general public in Hong Kong.

The Association held the first Inter-School Scrabble Championship last year and it has attracted 21 schools to participate in it, making it the largest inter-school Scrabble event in the school year. To attract more players to participate in the championship, the Association has divided the championship this year into 4 categories, namely the Primary and Secondary Novice categories and the Primary and Secondary Open categories. 23 schools participated in the competitions for the novice categories held on 23rd and 30th January.

The Open category which is of a higher level will be held on 12th March and 9th April. The Secondary Open category on 12th March will witness a total of 16 schools competing for the highest glory in the school Scrabble field. The details for the Open categories are as follows:
