EUCLID HUI - The Hong Kong Scrabble Champion 2022

The Hong Kong Scrabble Championship 2022 was held on 3 and 5 June 2022 this year.

16 elite local players have competed in the Championship this year. Following the tradition, they played 18 rounds of Scrabble over 2 days to compete for the Hong Kong Scrabble Champion title.

The Championship this year was HKSPA-rated and is well covered by an online event coverage web page. For the top table, live streaming was also available provided on HKSPA Facebook page and attracted audiences from the overseas as well. Selected games were also annotated and published on the event coverage website within a few hours of the completion of the game for all interested Scrabble players to review anytime at anywhere.

The competition this year was very intense and the Champion was only decided after all games were completed. Euclid finally won his title by winning 15 games and an accumulated spread of +1873 points. Matthew Choy followed and won the 1st runner-up award by winning 13 games. Thomson and Carson won 12 games, and were awarded the 2nd runner-up and 3rd runner-up respectively.

This is the third time Euclid crowded the Hong Kong Scrabble Champion title. He was also the Hong Kong Scrabble Champion in 2018 and 2021.

SEVERAL HONG KONG PLAYERS FINISHED THE ASTAR SCRABBLE CHALLENGE INTERNATIONAL WITH PREEMINENT RESULTS

The ASTAR Scrabble Challenge International ("ASCI") 2022 was organised on 21-22 May 2022. This annual event hosted by the University of Malaya since 2006 continued to happen online this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite the pandemic, Hong Kong had its largest group ever to the tournament this year. 16 contestants from Hong Kong participated in this online Scrabble tournament, which was also attended by players from 8 other countries / regions.

Players played 13-14 games online over two days. After the 2-day tournament, Hong Kong Scrabble players – Euclid HUI, Douglas TSANG, Thomson LAW Long Yin, Ian TSOI Yin and LOU Yuen Ching were awarded prizes in the ASTAR Scrabble Challenge International (ASCI) 2022 ("the Challenge").

It feels unreal being able to top the table on several occasions and win a couple of games against players inside the world's top 50.
